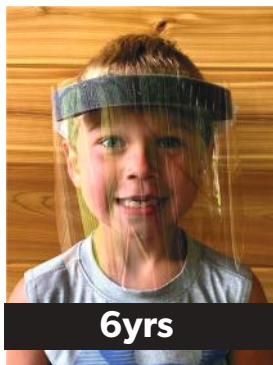

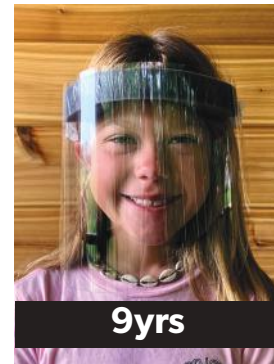


Kid-sized face shields from the makers of the Badger Shield:
Designed for kids to use in non-healthcare, educational, or day-care settings.



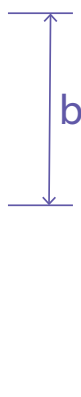
Benefits of Face Shields:

Lil' Badger Shields are barrier face shields designed for ages 2 to 12 years old:
We offer the Medium kid's size in packs of 10. If your child falls outside of the two sizes we sell you can download templates from our website to trim an Adult or a Kid's sizes. For proper fit, the shield should cover the entire face up to 1 1/2 - 2" in front of the ear.



Size chart:	S	M	L
Suggested Age Range*	2-5	3-8	10+
Lens Width (a)	10"	8.25"	13"
Lens Height (b)	8.25"	8.25"	9"
Elastic dia. (avg. light stretch)	6.5"	7"	8"

*Individual children may vary in shield size.
